The world is constantly changing and evolving. Social cataclysms and the war make their corrections. The attitude to the child, its education and upbringing change as well. Moral, ethical norms and values are undergoing transformations, and the culture of childhood is taking on new dimensions. The postmodernist paradigm alters the perception of the child and childhood. It is based on the shift of the child's image - from the child as a passive to an active member of the social community; from childhood as a stage of development to the idea of childhood as a social construct. This affects social sciences and humanities, thus highlighting the need for active and diverse understanding of the problems of the child and childhood, the child's education. Literature for children and youth is a mirror and an important factor of transformation processes. Text, discourse, broad and diverse social and cultural context are the target of multidisciplinary studies of current issues of children and childhood.

Guided by modern scientific postulates that justify communication between different scientific fields, while striving for a comprehensive research and polyphonic approach to a particular problem, I International Multidisciplinary Conference "Childhood. Literature. Culture. Education" is conceived as an interdisciplinary scientific dialogue between the participants.
